Seven Kings School is a successful all through school in the London Borough of Redbridge, with a strong local and national reputation. We are a mixed, multi-ethnic community school providing high quality education to local children of all abilities. All staff contribute to our vision in creating an all through school which is a model of exceptional practice for all of our community and beyond. There are approximately 2230 students on roll, 500 of these in our dynamic Sixth Form which brings together outstanding learners from across East London (50% of our Sixth Form) to join our own students and is an exciting place to study. The school is always oversubscribed and enjoys strong support from parents and governors. We are a 'harmonious school' with an excellent learning environment and exemplary behaviour.

Outcomes are consistently high in all phases and were once again excellent in 2023, placing us as one of the best state schools in the country. We are the most oversubscribed state school in the country. We were recently reaccredited World Class School status and are one of the Mayor of London's Schools for Success.

What we offer

The department consists of a Learning Leader and peripatetic staff. We work collaboratively with one another and within the Learning Partnership to nurture and develop classroom practice to ensure that the classroom experience that we provide contextualises learning that inspires our young musicians. The music department is dynamic and committed to fostering creativity, self-expression, and personal growth in our students. We take pride in providing a stimulating learning environment that encourages students to explore their potential and develop a lifelong appreciation of music. We aim to create an environment where creativity is fostered through composition work and where students explore diverse musical traditions. Music has its own extremely well-resourced and self-contained building, including 5 practice rooms and a designated IT Suite. The department is busy and thriving during lunchtimes and students regularly participate in Clubs, Spotlight Concerts and Buskers' Lunches. We have two large scale All-Through Concerts during the year which are always extremely well attended by parents. Our team of peripatetic teachers offer instrumental lessons on both sites in Strings, Piano, Guitar, Ukulele and Drumkit. In Year 4 all students take part in WCET in Violin and Ukulele.
