Seven Kings School

Seven Kings School is a successful all through school in the London Borough of Redbridge, with a strong local and national reputation. We are a mixed, multi-ethnic community school providing high quality education to local children of all abilities. All staff contribute to our vision in creating an all through school which is a model of exceptional practice for all of our community and beyond. There are approximately 2230 students on roll, 500 of these in our dynamic Sixth Form which brings together outstanding learners from across East London (50% of our Sixth Form) to join our own students and is an exciting place to study. The school is always oversubscribed and enjoys strong support from parents and governors. We are a 'harmonious school' with an excellent learning environment.

Outcomes are consistently high in all phases and were once again excellent in 2023, placing us as one of the best state schools in the country. We are the most oversubscribed state school in the country. We were recently reaccredited World Class School status and are one of the Mayor of London's Schools for Success.

staff and our high quality continuing professional development opportunities. Staff retention rates are high. What we are looking for

We are looking to appoint a well-qualified, creative and passionate teacher of Science who will join our successful science department. You will need to be an enthusiastic practitioner with strong subject knowledge.

Science at Seven Kings is a high profile successful subject with roughly half of our 500 strong KS5 taking A Level science; the department is a stable, highly professional team of 16 dedicated teachers. The science department offers an array of opportunities for our students to truly explore and get to grips with the subject through rich enrichment experiences.

You will work alongside established leaders within a highly collaborative department to develop learning and teaching across science and ensure high quality systems and structures are developed and maintained across the department. You will also be expected to help all learners access our rigorous curriculum, meaning all students receive a high quality education within Science.

In 2023 across our cohort of GCSE Combined and Separate Science 95% of students achieved G4+/G4,4+, with 84% achieving a G5+/G5,5+. With 24% of Combined Science students achieving G7,7+ 60% achieving G7+ in Separate Science (with 20% achieving a G9 on average across the 3 sciences).

Our Key Stage 5 team are passionate experts in their field of science who are restless at developing the curriculum and experience for our students and are passionate about their subjects and pedagogy at KS5.

opportunities. The right candidate can make something of this role and help lead the school further in its development and we are excited by this prospect.

What we offer

The department consists of a Learning Leader who makes up a team consisting of 16 teachers and three technicians who work collaboratively with one another and within the Learning Partnership to nurture and develop their classroom practice to ensure that the classroom experience that we provide contextualises learning that inspires the scientists of tomorrow. There are also two Deputy Learning Leaders with responsibility for Key Stage 4 and 5, along with Key Stage 5 Leaders for Biology, Physics and Chemistry. There are also two Lead Practitioners and two Senior Leaders in the Science team. The department is housed in fully equipped labs with one university standard laboratory.

Our team is testament to the school's ethos of continuous professional development; almost all members of the science team have progressed into roles of leadership both within the department and the wider school. If you are successful in joining our department, you will be continuously supported by a team of experienced practitioners who are passionate about their subject. This is evident in our pedagogy meetings where we discuss learning and teaching to continuously improve our delivery of content across the curriculum. We are scientists first, teachers second, striving to contextualise and break down complex scientific ideas for our wonderful students and provide them with the wider understanding that creates outstanding scientists.
